As we enter into “Reopening Step 3” please note that this guidance will remain in effect throughout the duration of the Governors COVID-19 Disaster Declaration and updates will be provided as needed as this is the final step of reopening at this time and until further notice.

Visitation Guidelines

Visitation Locations

- Two outdoor visitation areas located on the front Atrium patio
- One outdoor visitation area located in the Gazebo on the Memory Care Unit courtyard
- One indoor visitation area in the Formal Dining Room and one indoor visitation area in the Atrium

Daily Visitation Times

- 9:30 am to 11:30 am and 1:30 pm to 4:00 pm

Category	Step 3 of 3 Requirements
Outdoor Visitation	Outdoor based visits may continue with scheduling prior to each visit. Please call Activities to schedule at 814-563-6703. Outdoor visits must continue to utilize designated visitation areas and are required to follow all screening procedures and time limits. Each visit has a limit of 30 minutes and MUST be scheduled prior to arriving.
Indoor Visitation	Indoor visits in a designated neutral area are permitted upon scheduling. Screening procedures must be followed prior to entering building as well as practicing social distancing universal masking and hand hygiene recommendations. No visits are to be scheduled during meal times. Please call Activities to schedule at 814-563-6703. All visitors are prohibited to enter any other area within the building, including resident apartments. Each visit has a limit of 30 minutes and MUST be scheduled prior to arriving.

Additional Step 3 Guidelines

Category	Step 3 of 3 Requirements
Communal Dining	Residents and staff must maintain social distancing, wear masks at all times when not actively participating in eating ones meal, continue to utilize various locations in facility for assigned seating purposes. Assigned seating must be followed with the use of Atrium, Dining Room and Community Room for meal service.
Activities	Activity group size is unrestricted as long as social distancing, proper hand hygiene and use of universal masking are observed.
Non-Essential Personnel	This includes but not limited to barbers/beauticians and contractors. Such personnel must follow facility screening procedures prior to entering building, practice social distancing, universal masking and hand hygiene recommendations. Barber and hair stylist services are permitted following above recommendations and must utilize proper PPE. Facility based beauty shop services will be re-opening beginning September 23 rd and must be scheduled prior to attendance.
Volunteers	All volunteers must follow facility screening procedures prior to entering building, practice social distancing universal masking and hand hygiene recommendations
Outings	Through the facilities Activity Department resident outings may resume ensuring staff and residents practice social distancing, universal masking and hand hygiene recommendations.
