**Reopening Implementation Plan Step Three**  
**Effective: April 5, 2021**

The Suites at Rouse continues to adhere to the latest advisories with the top priority to ensure the health, safety and well-being of all residents and staff. Our facility has implemented precautionary measures to ensure appropriate care is delivered to residents in a safe and sanitary environment. Effective 4/5/2021, we enter into “Reopening Step 3” please note that this guidance will remain in effect throughout the duration of the Governors COVID-19 Disaster Declaration and updates will be provided as needed and until further notice. Please note, the community COVID-19 Transmission Level rate directly affects our reopening abilities, guidelines and requirements.

**Additional Step 3 Guidelines**

<b>Category</b>	<b>Step 3 of 3 Requirements</b>
Communal Dining	Residents and staff must maintain social distancing, wear masks at all times when not actively participating in eating ones meal, continue to utilize various locations in facility for assigned seating purposes. Assigned seating must be followed with the use of Atrium, Dining Room and Community Room for meal service.
Activities	Activities may be conducted with residents. Social distancing, hand hygiene, and universal masking are required.
Non-Essential Personnel	Non-essential personnel are allowed, with screening and additional precautions including social distancing, hand hygiene, and universal masking.
Volunteers	Volunteers are allowed. Screening, social distancing and additional precautions including social distancing, hand hygiene, and universal masking.
Facility Outings	Outings limited to no more than the number of people where social distancing between residents can be maintained. Appropriate hand hygiene, and universal making are required.



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Quarantine with Outings	Outings for non-essential or non-medical purposes are strongly discouraged. Residents attending outings that are considered high risk may be subject to quarantine upon return. High risk outings are considered to be:  <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. groups of 10 or more people</li><li>2. duration of the outing (overnight, vacation, out of state)</li><li>3. community positivity rate &gt;10%</li><li>4. those with any chronic or immunocompromised conditions</li></ol>
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**Visit Procedures**

1. Visits are to be held at the identified visitation stations only. We have two fabricated stations available, one in the formal dining room and one in the Atrium.
2. At this time, outdoor visitation is weather dependent and preferred.
3. Visitors must call ahead to schedule - no exceptions will be made.
4. Visitors must be screened prior to visit, staff will assist.
5. Visits will be held:

**Daily from 9 am to 11 am and 1 pm to 4 pm**

6. Visits are to be held for 30 minutes - maximum.
7. Two visitors are permitted at each visit and must maintain social distancing if the resident is NOT fully vaccinated.
8. If the resident is fully vaccinated, the resident can chose to have close contact (including touch) with their visitor while wearing a well-fitting face mask and performing hand-hygiene before and after the visit, per updated guidelines.
9. No food or drink is to be shared during the visit.
10. Masks must be worn by visitors and resident at all times
11. Call Activities at (814) 563-6703 between the hours of 8 am and 4 pm to schedule next day or future visits.

We kindly ask that all residents, families and visitors follow these guidelines and requirements as it is our responsibility to maintain a safe and comfortable environment for our residents and staff. Please do not hesitate to reach out if you have any questions.
