The Suites at Rouse continues to adhere to the latest advisories with the top priority to ensure the health, safety and well-being of all residents and staff. Our facility has implemented precautionary measures to ensure appropriate care is delivered to residents in a safe and sanitary environment. As always, The Suites at Rouse encourages you to refer to the CDC and PA DOH websites for more information. Please monitor www.rouse.org for updated information as guidelines are subject to change.

Effective 4/5/2021, we enter into “Reopening Step 3” please note that this guidance will remain in effect throughout the duration of the Governors COVID-19 Disaster Declaration and updates will be provided as needed and until further notice. Please note, the community COVID-19 Transmission Level rate directly affects our reopening abilities, guidelines and requirements. **Updates in red are effective May 5, 2021.**

Additional Step 3 Guidelines

Category	Step 3 of 3 Requirements
Communal Dining	Residents and staff must maintain social distancing, wear masks at all times when not actively participating in eating ones meal, continue to utilize various locations in facility for assigned seating purposes. Assigned seating must be followed with the use of Atrium, Dining Room and Community Room for meal service. All fully vaccinated residents can participate in dining without physical distancing in the same area. Masks are to be worn when entering/exiting the dining room. Those residents who are not fully vaccinated must be seated 6 feet away from others and wear a mask when not eating.
Activities	Activities may be conducted with residents. Social distancing, hand hygiene, and universal masking are required. If all residents are vaccinated, they do not have to wear face masks and may choose to have close contact as a group. However, if an unvaccinated resident is present, the entire group must wear a mask and the unvaccinated resident must physically distance themselves from the group.
Non-Essential Personnel	Non-essential personnel are allowed, with screening and additional precautions including social distancing, hand hygiene, and universal masking.
Visitation	All visitors must wear a mask, vaccinated or not, upon entering the building and when around others who are not part of their

	visitation group. Visitors must physically distance from other residents that are not part of their visit. Fully vaccinated residents and visitors may choose to have close contact and not wear a mask during their visit. Visitation must be scheduled and held in identified common areas, indoors or outdoors.
Volunteers	Volunteers are allowed with screening, social distancing and additional precautions including social distancing, hand hygiene, and universal masking.
Quarantine with Outings	Outings for non-essential or non-medical purposes are strongly discouraged. Residents attending outings that are considered high risk may be subject to quarantine upon return. High risk outings are considered to be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. groups of 10 or more people 2. duration of the outing (overnight, vacation, out of state) 3. community positivity rate >10% 4. those with any chronic or immunocompromised conditions

Visit Procedures

1. Visits are to be held at the identified visitation stations only. We have two fabricated stations available, one in the formal dining room and one in the Atrium.
2. At this time, outdoor visitation is weather dependent and preferred.
3. Visitors must call ahead to schedule - no exceptions will be made.
4. Visitors must be screened prior to visit, staff will assist.
5. Visits will be held:

Daily from 9 am to 11 am and 1 pm to 4 pm

6. Visits are to be held for 30 minutes - maximum.
7. Two visitors are permitted at each visit and must maintain social distancing if the resident is NOT fully vaccinated.
8. All visitors must wear a mask, vaccinated or not, upon entering the building and when around others who are not part of their visitation group.
9. Visitors must physically distance from other residents that are not part of their visit.
10. Fully vaccinated residents and fully vaccinated visitors may choose to have close contact and not wear a mask during their visit. Visitors must wear a well-fitting



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- face mask and performing hand-hygiene before and after the visit, per updated guidelines.
1. Call Activities at (814) 563-6703 between the hours of 8 am and 4 pm to schedule next day or future visits.
